

## **POOL RULES**

We want everyone to have a safe and happy summer at the pool this year; therefore, we have compiled a list of rules and regulations. Observing the following rules will assure a safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities this summer. These rules and regulations become a part of your lease agreement. Management reserves the right to refuse entry and or deny privileges to anyone at its sole discretion.

- Please observe proper dress code while in the clubhouse. No pool traffic will be allowed through the clubhouse. Swim wear or bare feet is not acceptable in the clubhouse at anytime.
- Please <u>ENTER</u> and <u>EXIT</u> the Pool Area from the <u>SIDE GATE ENTRANCE</u> and not through the Clubhouse. Everyone is required to show proper pool ID to the Life Guard before entering the Pool Area.
- Each additional guest pass is \$5.00. Guest passes may be purchased at the management office during normal business hours. Cash or check will be accepted. Residents will be responsible for all actions of their children and guests. Children in diapers are not permitted in the pool area.
- Management will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal property of any kind. Additionally, the cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible party.
- The pool will be open from 12 noon until 8pm daily. Closed on Monday. The pool may be closed at any time due to breakdowns, weather or operational difficulties at the pool manager/lifeguards discretion.
- No one under the age of 15 will be allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult (18 yrs, or older). Adults must show proof of age and remain at the pool during the entire stay. Anyone 15 or older must have a resident ID.

- Pool passes may be revoked for misuse or for reasons of misconduct as determined by the manager. Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing or any disturbances by or around the pool is strictly prohibited.
- No glassware, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs allowed. Any persons under the influence will not be allowed in the pool area.
- Admission will be denied to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections, or anyone wearing bandages.
- Appropriate swimwear is required in the pool area. No cut offs or thong bathing suits permitted. No street foot wear will be permitted in the pool area. No abusive or offensive language will be tolerated.
- Flotation devices are not permitted per Anne Arundel Co Dept of Health, with the exception of life vests only. First Aid supplies may be obtained from the Lifeguard.
- The pool area cannot be rented for any reason. Pets are not permitted in the pool area, except for those animals that provide handicap assistance.
- Please deposit all trash in the trash receptacles supplied.
- For the purpose of supporting non-swimmers, inner tubes, water wings, and all other flotation devices are not permitted at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the United States Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child in the water at all times.
